


PREFACE

FAOU, An Overview



Therefore, FAOU is bringing together professors from well-known universities and experts from leading international organizations to build competitive educational programs that allow students to gain new skills and knowledge.

This year, 2020, the university decided to extend largely its platform and prepare more than 50 new courses in various specialties. This new agenda was possible could be achieved only after the great reputation that we could create during 2019. Moreover, the university is planning to launch 3 new Master Degrees programs by 2021. Also, we are planning to launch FAOU Open Science Initiative, in the first quarter to support the efforts of open science sources initiatives around the world.

Mission & Duties


The Ambassadors are responsible to manage the local community created in their country, which will be located in social media groups, exclusively Facebook & LinkedIn). The created social media groups, will be a space for the ambassadors to invite people from their country, who are interested in FAOU mission, E-learning, Open Education, Open Science.

The Ambassadors will need to connect the members of this community by organizing events (conferences, workshops, etc), networking sessions (meetups, debates, etc). Or games and parties.

Also, the ambassadors are responsible to share in the groups latest activities of FAOU, updates worldwide about E-learning, Open Education, Open Science. And motivate the members to share their experiences, initiatives and projects.

Moreover, each ambassador will be the representative of FAOU in their country and for that will need to find partnership opportunities, and possibilities to support FAOU activities in their country.

All the ambassadors will have access automatically to the following benefits:


- Certificate of experience.

- Access to an international network across 92 countries.
- Network nationally with leading organizations, companies, institutions, etc.
- Commissions for the purchased FAOU courses.
- Possibility to become a permanent member of FAOU.
- Be representative of FAOU in your country and get the possibility to be hired locally.

To motivate the ambassadors of FAOU, there will be more benefits based on the ambassador status. Such free access to FAOU courses, higher commissions rates of the sold courses at FAOU platform, etc.

REGULATIONS

A - Basic rules

- All ambassadors have equal rights and responsibilities, regardless of their nationality, race, religion.
- Racism, religious bias and arrogance, are not welcome and discussions on such topics must not be open in our meetings or activities.
- Ambassadors should have their work contract as soon as possible and to get support from the management team for any application they want to send for other programs or activities.

B – Communities Rules

- Slack channels are created for coordination work. Messages out of subject are not allowed.
- Ambassadors are always welcome to politely introduce their opinions, suggestions, without demotivating others.
- At communities groups ambassadors can only share posts related to FAOU activities or information from Open Education initiatives worldwide.
- The management team can assist the ambassadors with updates about FAOU, if requested.

C - Promotion and Disciplinary Rules

- Promotional / motivational guideline are adopted to rate ambassadors who are either active or efficient in their services.
- In the same light, disciplinary guidelines are adopted to temporarily or permanently block access to all ambassadors who violate laid down principles, rules and regulations (decision to be made and executed by management team).

D - Rights and Benefits as an Ambassador

- Certificate for who successfully reach the minimum ambassadors rank (Bronze Ambassador)
- Flexible working time based on results.
- Free Student Card (or 10 vouchers), for who was able to reach Silver Rank.
- Possibility to extend ambassadorship period with approval of management team.
- 10 % commission of each payment to buy a course at our platform from members of their community.
- Platinium Ambassadors will receive up to 30 % commission of each payment to buy a course at our platform from members of their community.
